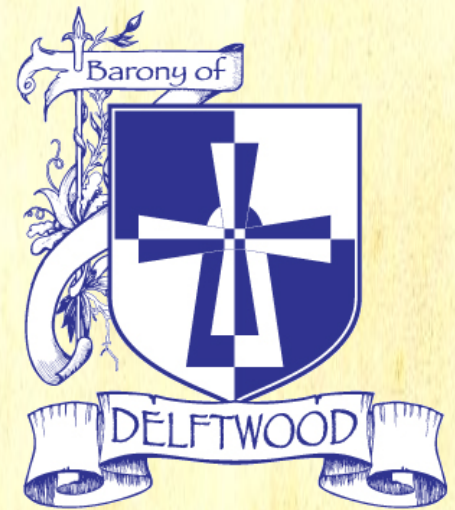

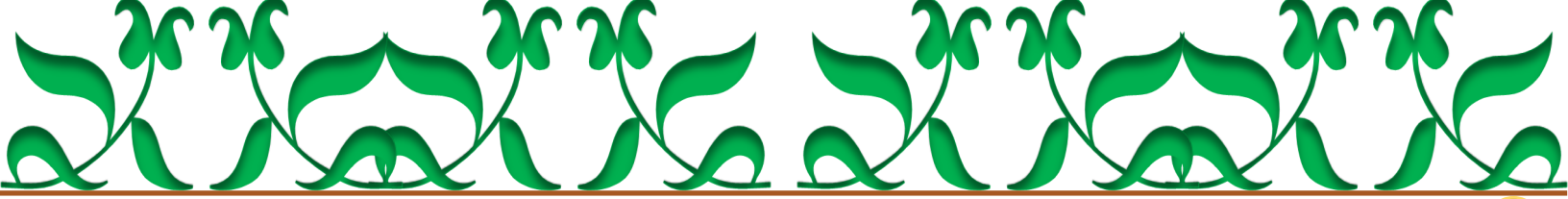

April 2013: Preparing for Spring

"Helpers did the digging, weeding, planting, felling and trimming of trees, fruit picking, grass cutting, the making and repairing of walls and hedges, ponds and ditches, and all the unskilled jobs that should not take up too much of the monks' time." (MacLean p. 36-37)

As the winter snows have come and gone (and come and gone, and come and gone), it has become apparent that I will need to do some repair in addition to my plans for expansion. Some of the stakes have gotten rather loose and are listing. They will need to be hammered back in. I believe this is the result of setting them up during the very dry summer, while this winter has been very wet. There is now the great opportunity to drive the stakes deeper into the ground.

In large medieval gardens, these repair activities would have been accomplished by hired labor. In my case it will just be myself and Fergus.

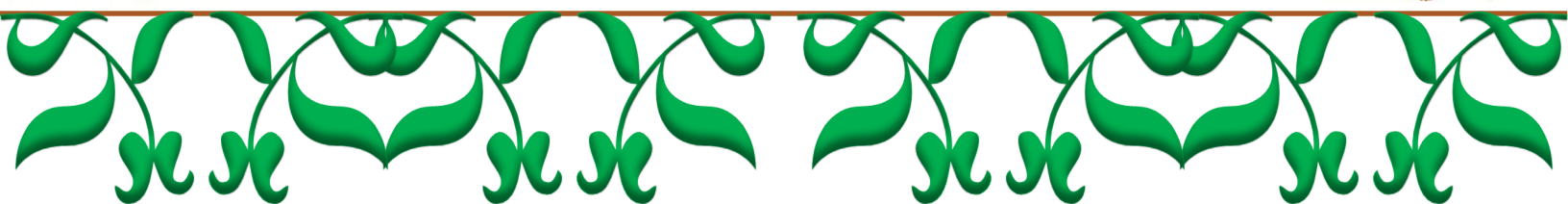
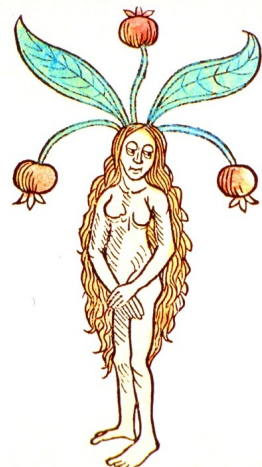
Taking stock of what has survived, it is apparent that most of the herbs are growing strong.

The parsley has returned (growing even in the chill), and some of the green onions and leeks show signs of new growth already. Since the marigolds are annuals, I will need to replant those as well as the peas and beans.

My plans for expansion include adding a new section of garden and planting root vegetables, including parsnips, turnips, and radishes, and also growing cabbage and expanding my allium-family vegetables (onions, garlic, leeks, etc.)

I'm so very excited for spring to get back to planting and growing.

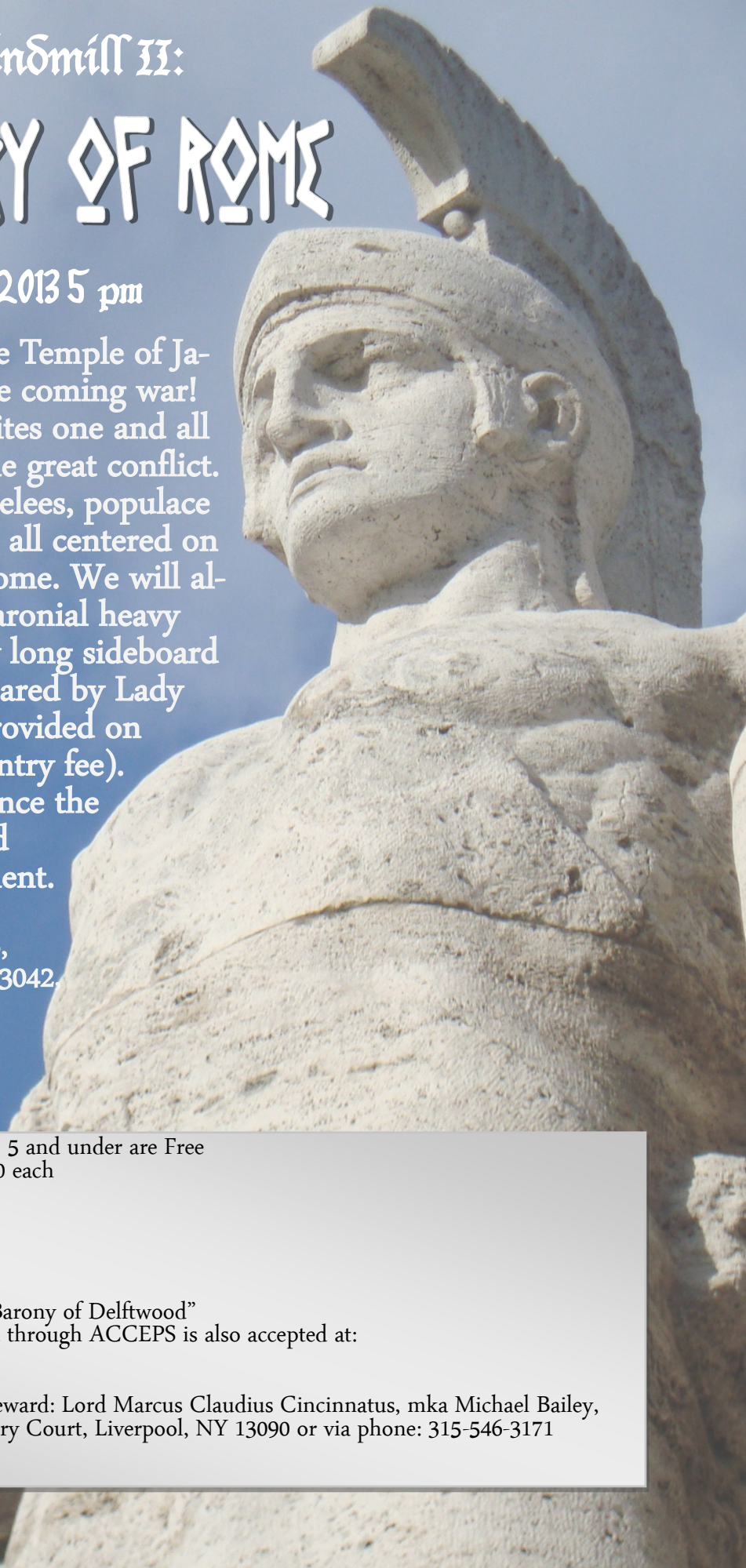

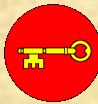
