Join us again at ARISE at the Farm in Chittenango to put on a demo for children and adults of all abilities. We're looking for fighters, fencers, A&S display and active A&S demonstrations. We're looking for pavilions, pageantry, day shades, heraldry, etc. We need people to put on our usual fun-filled demo (like we do at the Fort - only with barnyard animals).

We will be able to set up pavilions, day shades, and other "big stuff" the night before (starting around 6 PM), and we can have people at the Farm overnight as well.

I'd like to have people at the Farm around 9 AM to begin day-of set-up and martial inspections, so we can start right at 11 when the public will start to show up.

We can bring food for us, or purchase lunch from the Chittenango Rotary.

Directions to the Farm:

Easy Directions: use Route 81 to Route 481. From here take Exit 3E to Fayetteville. This dumps you out on route 5 which is also Genesee Street. You'll know you're in the right place when you pass the Dewitt Wegman's on the left seconds after exiting. Take Route 5 about 12 miles through the village of Fayetteville, past Green Lakes State Park, and into the town of Chittenango. As you go through town you'll come to a 5 corner stop light. Route 5 will turn to the right to Canastota -DON'T FOLLOW IT. At this point go straight onto Lakeport Road. After approximately 4 miles you'll come upon a stop light with a school bus garage on the corner. This is the Lakeport and New Boston Road intersection. Take New Boston Rd. for about a 1/2 mile until you come upon ARISE at the Farm on your Right. Turn at the sign! (there are 3 Driveways to the Farm. Take one of the first two.)

From Coppertree:

Take Route 5 into Chittenango - Turn right onto Lakeport Road After approximately 4 miles, you'll come upon a stop light with a school bus garage on the corner. This is the Lakeport/New Boston Road intersection. take New Boston Road for about 1/2 mile until you come upon the Farm on the right. Turn at the sign for ARISE at the Farm (take one of the first two driveways).

From the Northern Suburbs:

Take Route 31 East to Lakeport. At light in Lakeport, turn right on Lakeport Road. Follow Lakeport Road south to North Chittenango. At the traffic light at the intersection of Lakeport Road and New Boston Road/Fyler Road, turn left onto New Boston Road. ARISE @ the Farm is about a half mile on the right hand side. There is a sign out at the driveway.
