OFFICER REPORTS

**** Baron & Baroness** - Her Excellency Helene says, "We exist!" They had a really awesome event. They want to congratulate again Myskia for her Keystone, Mathew for his AoA, and Ian (known as Keyard) for becoming Fencing Champion. The site looked awesome! Felicity, Fridrich, Finn, Lijsbet, and Margaret made many of the new banners that went up in the hall and the armor dump covers too. We love beautifying Delftwood! His Excellency added, "What she said." It is also noted that Dragos received a Keystone, although he's now in Coppertree. They should congratulate him, too.

**** Pursuivant** - Her Excellency Olivia will be soon. We will come back to her. (Report from later) Mistress Alhedyis retired after 8 years. ** *Chancellor Minor* - Sultana says nothing is really going on and there were things to do at last week's event.

** *Chatelaine* - Desi gives all of us a déjà-vu moment as she repeats the same line from her Chronicler report regarding stepping up as Kingdom Chatalaine. Therefore, she must step down from being local Chatalaine. Fridrich is her deputy and has agreed to will step up.

Liverpool library has demanded we return for another demo. They would prefer the evening of Wednesday, June 12. Desi asks if it would be ok to move fight practice for the demo and if we would be okay with this? The Knight Marshal says, "Let's do it!" Please let Fridrich know what demos you would want to do at this demo.

OTHER BUSINESS

** Edward would like to put in bid for Wildwood. Stewards for the events would be Edward and Ralff. The dates were previously approved as placeholders.

** Anastasie would like to buy 2 sets of atlatl. She would like to get the lesser expensive ones sooner than later, so they can be assembled. It is \$132 for the 2 sets. The proposal is seconded and approved unanimously.

** Michael would like to get a 36" wide mat to use for York rounds, which is used for 100-yd shoots that are usually done at events.

We would like to do it at Wildwood. He will look into costs and bring to next meeting.

** Lijsbet mentions that one of the day camps that YMCA puts on (in Baldwinsville) wants to do a medieval themed week and has asked us to do a demo at the camp. The camp is 9 am to 4 pm, but most likely the demo would not be all day. They have asked for Thursday, July 11. If there is interest, please let Lijsbet know. Desi asked for Lijsbet to email information to her so it can be forwarded to the Chatalaine's list to see if there is interest from other places as well.

** Lisjbet also brings up that the crew who made the banners. She asks if the Barony would be interested in reimbursing the people \$31.23. The motion is seconded. There is one dissenting vote and the motion passes.

** Felicity brings up the armor dumps and that the felt was changed to a heavier fabric called target. Margaret fronted the money for the target and Felicity asks for \$38.32 for reimbursement. Felicity also notes she has made the water cooler covers and gate sign. If the Barony would like to buy them from her that is an option. There are 4 covers at \$5 each and the gate sign is \$10 for a total of \$30. Gullaime makes a motion for reimbursement. There is one dissenting vote and the motion passes.

** Helene reminds us that we helped at ARISE at the Farm in the pouring rain (until it became sticky-hot) last year. This year the event is on July 27, which is the middle Saturday of Pennsic. She asks us to think about this, but realizes that people may not be available. If there is any interest, please let Helene know. Desi asks Helene to email information the she can send across the Chatelaines' listserv as well.

** Finn gives a big thanks to those who stayed to help clean-up the event site to the bitter end, including people from the Hael and Tim, at his first event.

Seeing that there is no other business, the meeting is closed by Sir Yngvar at 7:48 PM.
