The meeting is opened by Sir Yngvar at 7:00 PM.

OFFICER REPORTS

**** Baron & Baroness** - Baroness Helene says they are proud as we had many people attend White Hart. About 1/3 of the field was from Delftwood. All of the Lords did well, despite all the tortures the ladies put them through. In fact, His Excellency was a parry device. It was a long trip for all to take – it is appreciated that everyone went.

Ice Dragon is coming up. It is encouraged for anyone to put items in the Pent or the other competitions. His Excellency will be entering the Pent.

Their Excellencies are issuing a challenge to the artisans of Delftwood. Over the next four Delftwood events, they will give a basic theme and a medium in which to work. They are in the process of talking to Marcus to start the competition at the Windmill Tourney (else, it will start at Wildewood).

The tournaments:

1. A textile challenge with a theme of blue. (Windmill)
2. A wood working/leather challenge with a heraldry theme. (Wildewood)
3. A cooking/brewing challenge with a theme of blueberries. (Yule)
4. A jewelry/metalwork challenge with a theme of argent. (February event)

Their Highnesses are intending to do pilgrimages to travel through Aethelmearc. We will be writing a letter to inviting Their Highnesses to both the Tournament of the Windmill and Wildewood in hopes They can attend at least one of these events. If you would be interested in spearheading a Delftwood history component for this event, please contact Their Excellencies.

**** Pursuivant** - Baroness Olivia says she held the banner for Their Excellencies at White Hart. She notes that Ice Dragon and Crown Tournament are events that often need heralds, so if you are interested, Olivia can help connect you to the person in charge. Lastly, she is looking to find out who is active/inactive in the area so she can remove people from the online OP and move them to the another area.

**** Web Minister** - Amalie says not much has been done on the website this past month. She also reminds all that profile submissions are still being accepted.

Information about the photo on Page 3 (from its Flickr page):

Lincoln Medieval Bishops' Palace is a 12th century stone enclosure fortress standing almost in the shadow of Lincoln Cathedral and is one of the most impressive medieval clerical houses in England. There are the remains of the 12th century great hall & kitchen together with Bishop Alnwick's 15th century entrance tower and chapel range. Commanding sweeping views over the ancient city the medieval bishops' palace was once among the most important buildings in the country, the administrative centre of the largest diocese in medieval England stretching from the Humber to the Thames. Its architecture reflected the enormous power and wealth of the bishops. Having hosted visits from King Henry VIII and King James I, the palace was sacked by Royalist troops during the Civil War.

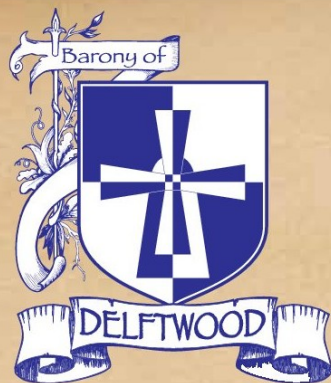
