Out of the Box

Don't worry, Delftwood history is still safely in a box, but some of it will be re-printed here each month as well. This month's Out of the Box is reprinted from the Delftwood Wailer, May AS 18 (1983).

McClain's Birch Twig Disaster

Creator: John McClain

5 lbs Mutton & Frison Light, Hopped, Malt Extract
10 lbs Yellow Birch Twigs,
picked just prior to budding in the spring
1 tsp Salt
5 gal Water
1 pkg Bottom Fermenting Lager Yeast

Method - Steep birch twigs in 5 Gal water for several days prior to brewing. Strain, heat to boiling. Add malt and salt. Cool. Add yeast. Ferment in primary vessel for three or four days before transferring to carboy. Bottle when specific gravity reaches 1010.

Description - This beer had several unexplained problems. The fermentation stuck, and the brew never cleared. Also, the flavor of the birch twigs (similar to spearmint) overpowered the malt. In the final analysis, a refreshing beverage, but hard to recognize as beer.

Wild Ginger Beer

6 lbs John Bull Dark Malt
2 lbs Brown Sugar
1 oz. Brewer's Gold Hops
1 oz. Salt
Juice From 1 Lemon
5 gal. Water
2 oz. Sliced and Crushed
Wild Vermont Ginger
1 Pkt Top Fermenting Yeast

Method - Heat water with malt, sugar, salt lemon, and ginger. Add hops in cheesecloth "teabag" toward end of brewing cycle. Let cool to 90°, pitch yeast. Skim daily. When vigorous fermentation stops, remove hops and transfer to secondary fermentor- a glass carboy with a fermentation lock. Bottle when at least 30 seconds elapses between bubbles in lock.

Description - Weird, but flavorful. Everyone who tasted it agreed that not similar potion had, ever passed his lips. Refreshing, but not the kind of beer you want if you're having more than one. Charlie suggests cutting down on hops the next time.
